PROGRAMME

Aims of the course: This gynaecological and non-gynaecological cytology course is aimed at cellular pathology trainees of ST1 grade who have little exposure to cytology prior to the course. This course provides an opportunity to understand some theoretical basis of diagnostic cytology with an opportunity to work at the multiheader microscope with the trainers. It also provides an introduction to the National Cervical Screening Programme and a familiarity with management of cytological abnormalities. The autopsy component will be interactive 'tutorials' covering some key areas of autopsy practice.
